3. **Financial Report – April**
 - a. April income was \$3,000; payments for jazz festival and cookie dough sales
 - b. April expenses were \$6,000; most were remaining winter competition expenses and band review reimbursements
 - c. Bank balance is approximately \$5,000
 - i. Need approximately \$7,000-\$8,000 for fall start-up
 - ii. Still to deposit are a United Way contribution and a couple of fair share contributions
 - d. Carnegie expenses
 - i. Projected to be a bit less than originally estimated
 - ii. Waiting on transportation and misc. invoices
 - iii. \$2,000 start-up funds were returned to general fund
 - e. Financial report approved with no changes

 - i. 2011-2012 band schedule will be available at awards event
 - ii. Percussion and Guard training sessions held throughout summer – TBA

 - v. Only 4 or 5 Super Saturday rehearsals next fall – only field show drill will be rehearsed
 - vi. Monday night rehearsals will return for music and parade block rehearsal
 - vii. Four potential field show competitions in fall: Del Oro, Lodi, Fairfield, Dublin
 - viii. Winter Symphonic Band & Wind Ensemble concert is 12/05
 - ix. Winter Jazz Band concert is 12/06
 - 1. Trying “Theatre in the Round” concept for jazz band concerts this year
 - 2. Smaller venue – in the theatre, around tables with light refreshments

6. Ongoing Items

- a. Fundraising Programs
 - i. Lynn Koyama will continue as scrip coordinator unless someone else would like to take over
 - ii. Sponsor letters – available in band room
 - iii. Scrip Programs
 - 1. e-Scrip (Safeway, etc): “Laguna Creek High School Band Boosters” is enrolled in this program. The group ID is 500020512. Sign up by going to www.escrip.com and click on “Sign Up.”
 - 2. Raleys and BelAir (Quality of Life): This program is run through the Laguna Creek High School PTSO. You can get a card either through the PTSO or directly from Raleys or BelAir. You then go to www.raleys.com to register your card. Go to “Neighborhood” and then “Quality of Life Card.” Find “Click Here to Register Your Card.” Once your card is registered, you need to let the Band and PTSO know what your card number is so that PTSO can reimburse the band for any money that your card earns during the year.
 - 3. Nugget Market/Food 4 Less: The BBC will receive a 3% contribution for each dollar spent. Each person receives a “scrip card” which that person then “loads” and activates. Make sure you put “Laguna Creek High School Band Booster Club” under “beneficiaries”, not your student’s name. Get your card from Sheron Morris.
 - 4. SaveMart Supermarkets S.H.A.R.E.S Program: BBC has S.H.A.R.E.S. cards. Show your card when shopping and the BBC receives a maximum of 3%.
 - 5. Great Lakes Scrip: sign up through www.Shopwithscrip.com. Be sure to enter your student’s name. LCHS BBC Enrollment Code is **EC97A5DL2L732**.
 - iv. Other Available Programs

1. i-Give.com: This website is for everyday online shopping. If you go to the online store through iGive.com, the BBC will receive a percentage of each purchase. The BBC will get 1.5% of your purchase donated to it. Go to <http://www.iGive.com/LCHSBBC> for a customized sign-up link.
2. www.Goodsearch.com: This is a site powered by the Yahoo search engine. When you first go to the web site, you have to chose your charity in the “Who Do You GoodSearch For?” drop down bar. Type in “Laguna Creek High School Band Booster Club.”
3. GoodShop.com: This is like iGive.com. You go to the web store through this site (www.GoodShop.com) and a percentage of your purchase is given to BBC.
