

## Disneyland 2012

**The Plan:** To march in the Disneyland Parade, to attend a Disney Performing Arts Workshop and to perform on stage in Disneyland.

**The Dates:** April 1, 2012 to April 4, 2012.

**The Details:** The students will be leaving taking tour bus about 1pm on Sunday, April 1, 2012 for Anaheim. They will spend all of Monday and Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Parks. They will load the buses to return home about midnight after spending the day at the park on Tuesday and head back home to Elk Grove.

**The Cost:** \$375.00 per student. \$175.00 per chaperone

**What does this cover for students?** A tour bus ride down and back to Anaheim, a 2-night stay at the Embassy Suites Anaheim North Hotel in quad rooms and including breakfast, a 2-Day Park Hopper ticket for Disneyland and California Adventure Parks, participation in a Disney Performing Arts Workshop, a performance on stage in Disneyland, a Magic Music Days T-shirt, and miscellaneous expenses such as the cost of the equipment truck.

**What does this cover for Chaperones?** A tour bus ride down and back to Anaheim, a 2-night stay at the Embassy Suites Anaheim North Hotel in double rooms and including breakfast, and a 2-Day Park Hopper ticket for Disneyland and California Adventure Parks. Only Chaperones will be allowed to go backstage and to attend the Disney Performing Arts Workshop. The Band is allowed 1 chaperone per 10 students for each of these activities. If there are more chaperones than allowed, then a meeting will be held to work out the details.

**What is extra?** All meals and souvenirs. Remember, the Parks meals are expensive. Meals can run \$20.00 each. The hotel will provide breakfast each day so the students will need money for lunch and dinner.

**How do I sign up my student?** Forms are available online on the website and in the classroom.

**When do I have to have all the forms turned in??** **NOW!!!** We need the forms by this Friday, January 20, 2012, so that we can tell who is going. We have to know how many rooms to reserve. The forms that need to be turned in are the Payment Contract (everybody needs to turn this in, even if not going on the trip) and the Student-Parent Agreement/Statement of Commitment-Parent and Student. Chaperones need to turn in the Statement of Commitment-Chaperone form by this date.

**When do I have to have all the money paid by??** All money **MUST** be paid by March 9, 2012 (the contract states the 10<sup>th</sup> but that is wrong!). There will be no refunds after February 10, 2012. All cancellations must be in writing. Payments can be made

through PayPal. All checks should be made out to the LCHS BBC with the student's name on them.

**Are there payments options?** Yes. They are outlined on the Payment Contract.

**Can family members attend and not be chaperones?** YES!! The band has a block of rooms reserved at the Embassy Suite Anaheim North. To reserve a room and to get the best price on Disney ParkHopper tickets, complete the Family Hotel and Ticket Reservation Form. The cost for the 2-Day Park Hopper ticket is \$124.00 for each person. This money must be paid by March 9, 2012 to the LCHS BBC. It can be paid through PayPal with a small convenience fee charged.

FAQs: (this will be added to as more questions are asked...so check back on the website)

1. *There is a pool at the hotel...will my student be allowed to go swimming?* No. We have to have a lifeguard (not a student lifeguard) and special district permission. It is a liability.
2. *Can I ride the bus and not chaperone???* Yes, as long as there is space. It will cost between \$100-\$125 per person to ride the bus.
3. *Can I take my younger child with me on the bus??* Yes, if there is space and by arrangements. We have taken younger siblings (with their parents).
4. *Can I chaperone and take my younger child with me on the trip?* There are two ways that this works: either you pay the full room price for both nights or you must find another chaperone who agrees to share a room with you and your younger child.
5. *Can my band student share a room with me?* No. This is a trip is an experience for the students. In order to get the full experience, they share rooms with other students. It really does work out!!!
6. *Can I go backstage if I am not a chaperone?* No. This is Disneyland's rule.
7. *Can a child/student not performing go back stage?* No. This is Disneyland's rule.
8. *How will all the equipment get to Disneyland?* We will need someone to drive a Budget Truck. This does allow that person and one helper to go back stage!!! It is an awesome experience. Let Sheron know if you want to drive the truck.
