The Laguna Creek High School Band and Color Guard will be taking part in Disney's Performing Arts OnStage on Saturday, April 23rd OR Sunday, April 24th. The group will leave around 1pm on Friday, April 22, 2022. Upon arrival in Anaheim, the group will check into the hotel for a good night's sleep! The group will march in the Main Street parade (day to be announced later). The group will leave Anaheim on Monday, April 25th in the evening. Time is determined by bus drivers drive schedule. We should arrive back in Elk Grove around 3-4am on April 26th.

Arrangements have been made to stay at Embassy Suites Anaheim North. Stay at this hotel includes a complimentary made to order breakfast.

The LCHS BBC has arranged for two buses with a total of 112 seats. It is essential that you submit your reservation **NOW!!** The seats are on a first come, first serve basis!

There might be spots for Chaperones!! Chaperones do not share beds but do share rooms! Let me know who you want to room with, please.

Want to go but don't want to chaperone? There is a block of rooms reserved for non-chaperones. Complete the Family Reservation Form. You might even be able to travel down on the bus! Seats will be made available once the students reserve their seats. There is a charge for this.

Cost: \$650.00 for all students, chaperones and others wanting to ride the bus.

This covers three night stay at the Embassy Suites Anaheim North, a wonderful breakfast each morning, a 3-day Park Hopper Ticket, T-shirt, bus transportation and gas for the equipment trailer.
Remaining meals and souvenirs are extra.

Deposit/Contract Deadline: Friday, October 15th. ***Return the Payment Contract even if your student is not going on the trip.***

A **deposit of \$200.00 per person** is due at this time along with a signed copy of the attached Behavior Contract and Statement of Commitment-Student and the Payment Contract. Checks are to be made out to LCHS BBC. **Credit Card payments will be accepted** either through the website or by contacting Mrs. Morris. Add 2% to the amount paid, please. Venmo is also accepted with no extra fee added.

BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

As a student of Laguna Creek High School, as a member of the Laguna Creek High School Band and Color Guard, and as a participant, I understand that I am responsible for my behavior and for my contribution in making this a positive, memorable experience for everyone involved. I understand that I am representing my family, my school and my community.

In addition, I understand and agree to the following rules:

1. I will show respect at all times to all adult personnel and cooperate with their requests. This includes, but is not limited to, the band director, chaperones, bus drivers, hotel personnel, and theme park personnel.
2. I will show respect at all times to all other students on the trip
3. At NO time and under NO circumstances will I be in any hotel room with a member of the opposite sex unless a chaperone is present.
4. At NO time will I participate in any illegal activities. This includes, but is not limited to, smoking tobacco, drinking alcoholic beverages, smoking or consuming illegal substances, shoplifting, or breaking the law in any manner.
5. I will be on time for all departures and agree to follow the itinerary as well as any modifications made to it by the band director/chaperones. I agree to be ready in proper attire (no immodest clothing) and with all belongings, instruments, music and other equipment for which I am responsible.
6. I will be in my assigned hotel room by the designated curfew as determined by the band director/chaperones.
7. I will remain in my assigned room until time for breakfast. If I need to leave my room, I will obtain the permission of my chaperone.
8. I will respect hotel property and maintain my room in the condition it was when I arrived. I will pick up all my garbage before leaving my room each time and place it in the proper container. My parents will be held financially responsible for any loss or damage as determined by hotel personnel.
9. I understand that I will be unable to charge anything to my hotel room. This includes, but is not limited to, long distance phone calls, wifi, room service, pay for view television, or pay for view movies.
10. I agree to keep the bus clean, to follow the rules of the bus company, and to follow the directions of the bus drivers at all times.
11. I agree to follow all rules as outlined in "Student Rules" which will be provided prior to trip.
12. I agree that at all times and in all circumstances I will behave in a responsible and mature manner. I will not become involved in any physical or verbal altercations.

Any adult who is informed of or witnesses any violation of these rules will report the incidence to the band director and the school administration, if necessary.

As a direct result of the report of a violation, the following consequence will occur:

1. I understand that if I violate rules #3 and #4, it will result in automatic removal from the group. My parent/guardian will be contacted. They will be required to make immediate arrangements for my return home at their expense, and the incident will be reported to school administration.
2. I understand that if I violate any of the other rules, it will result in disciplinary action such as being assigned to the band director/chaperone for continuous supervision. If the behavior warrants, at the discretion of the band director, my parent/guardian will be contacted to make immediate arrangements for my return home at their expense. School administration will be notified.

STUDENT-PARENT BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

Do you want to go to Disneyland and stay with the group? You can! The group will be staying at the Embassy Suites Anaheim North. The LCHS BBC has reserved a block of rooms. If you want to go on the trip and stay with the group, please complete the section below. Payment will be due to the LCHS BBC by no later than January 14, 2022. All rooms not being used will be released back to the hotel on January 14, 2022.

The cost is \$580.00 for three nights for up to six people. Each room has two queen beds in the bedroom along with a couch bed in the living room. Parking is \$10/night/car.
